
AWLS 18350 & 18650 BATTERIES

STRUCTURE



- **A** POSITIVE POLE
- B RED LED LIGHT: INDICATES THE BATTERY IS BEING CHARGED, BLUE LED LIGHT: INDICATES THE BATTERY IS FULLY CHARGED
- C INTERNAL PROTECTION CIRCUIT
- D MICRO USB OR TYPE-C CHARGING PORT
- **E** QUALITY LIOION RECHARGEABLE BATTERY CELL
- **P** NEGATIVE POLE

CHARGING BY LI-ION BATTERY CHARGER

- BATTERY MUST BE CHARGED BY A 4.2V LI-ION BATTERY CHARGER WITH CONSTANT CURRENT-CONSTANT VOLTAGE (CC-CV) METHOD AT ROOM TEMPERATURE, THE STANDARD CHARGING CURRENT IS 0.2C (0.2 NOMINAL CAPACITY)
- THE CHARGER SHOULD HAVE FULL CHARGE CUT-OFF DETECTION FUNCTION
- BATTERY CANNOT BE CHARGED WITH POLARITY REVERSED

CHARGING BY THE USB PORT

- WHEN THE PLUG IS INSERTED INTO THE SOCKET, THE RED LED LIGHT ON POSITIVE TERMINAL SIDE TURNS ON, INDICATING THAT THE BATTERY IS BEING CHARGED
- WHEN THE BLUE LED LIGHT ON POSITIVE TERMINAL SIDE TURNS ON, IT INDICATES THAT THE BATTERY IS FULLY CHARGED
- BATTERY MUST BE CHARGED AT OPERATING TEMPERATURE RANGE: 50 113 °F

NOTE: IT IS NORMAL THAT BATTERY MAY BE HOT WHEN CHARGING. TO PREVENT SCALDING, PLEASE DO NOT TOUCH THE POSITIVE BUTTON WHEN CHARGING.

STANDARD DISCHARGING METHOD

- DISCHARGING BY POSITIVE (+) AND NEGATIVE (-) TERMINALS
- THE DISCHARGE CUT-OFF VOLTAGE IS 2.5V
- THE BATTERY MUST BE DISCHARGED AT OPERATING TEMPERATURE RANGE 32 130 °F

CAUTION

- FULLY CHARGE BATTERY BEFORE FIRST USE.
- BATTERY'S POSITIVE TERMINAL MAY BE HOT WHEN CHARGING, DO NOT TOUCH IT.
- DO NOT SHORT CIRCUIT, KEEP AWAY FROM LOOSE CHANGE AND METAL OBJECTS.
- DO NOT IMMERSE BATTERY IN ANY LIQUID/WATER.
- DO NOT PLACE THE BATTERY IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT OR HEAT, KEEP AWAY FROM FIRE.
- DO NOT CRUSH. HIT, IMPACT, DAMAGE. DISASSEMBLE, OR MODIFY THE BATTERY.
- DO NOT REVERSE THE POSITIVE (+) AND NEGATIVE (-) TERMINALS WHEN CHARGING OR USING THE BATTERY.
- IMMEDIATELY STOP USING IF BATTERY HAS ABNORMALITIES, SUCH AS SMELL. HEAT, DISCOLORATION, OR DEFORMRTY.
- FOR (BATTERY ELECTROLYTES) EXPOSURE, RINSE IMMEDIATELY WITH WATER, AND SEEK MEDICAL TREATMENT.
- KEEP THE BATTERY AWAY FROM CHILDREN OR PETS.
